






Figure 3. Transfer Characteristics





Figure 5. On-Resistance vs Drain Current










Figure 4. On-Resistance vs Gate Voltage








Figure 7. Capacitance Characteristics





Figure 8. Stored Energy vs Drain to Source Voltage






Figure 10. Reverse Conduction Characteristics




Figure 11. Reverse Conduction Characteristics




Figure 12. Safe Operating Area






Figure 13. Avalanche Current vs Pulse Time (UIS)










Figure 14. Maximum Power Dissipation vs Case Temperature




Figure 16. Inductive Switching Loss vs Drain Current





Figure 18. Inductive Switching Loss vs Gate Resistance






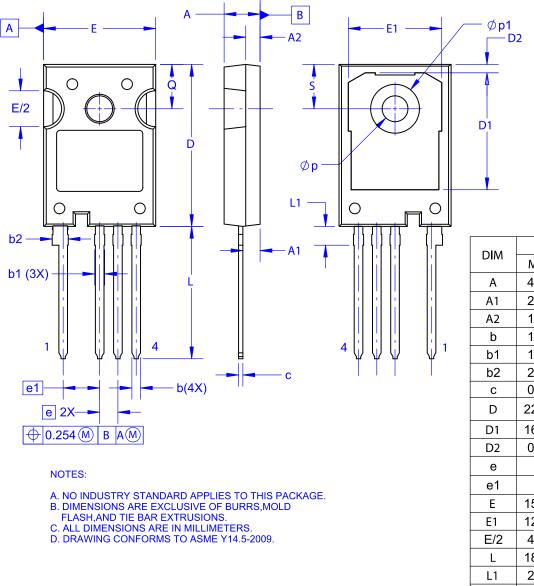


Figure 20. Thermal Response Characteristics
