

Note: The channel-to-ambient thermal resistance, R_{th(ch-a)}, and the drain power dissipation, P_D, vary according to the board material, board area, board thickness and pad area. When using this device, be sure to take heat dissipation fully into account.

Note 1: If a reverse bias is applied between gate and source, this device enters $V_{(BR)DSX}$ mode. Note that the drain-source breakdown voltage is lowered in this mode.

Note 2: Let V_{th} be the voltage applied between gate and source that causes the drain current (I_D) to below (1 mA for this device). Then, for normal switching operation, $V_{GS(ON)}$ must be higher than V_{th} , and $V_{GS(OFF)}$ must be lower than V_{th} . This relationship can be expressed as: $V_{GS(OFF)} < V_{th} < V_{GS(ON)}$.






Fig. 5.3.1 Switching Time Test Circuit





Fig. 6.1 Marking




Fig. 7.1 I_D - V_{DS}




Fig. 7.2 I_D - V_{GS}




Fig. 7.3 R_{DS(ON)} - V_{GS}




Fig. 7.4 R_{DS(ON)} - V_{GS}




Fig. 7.5 R_{DS(ON)} - I_D




Fig. 7.6 R_{DS(ON)} - T_a







Fig. 7.7 V_{th} - T_a



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Fig. 7.8 |Y_{fs}| - I_D




Fig. 7.9 IDR - VDS




Fig. 7.10 C - V_{DS}




Fig. 7.11 t - I_D






Fig. 7.12 Dynamic Input Characteristics











Fig. 7.14 P_D - T_a
