

DESCRIPTION D70401 HDMI to CSI Add-On for the RK3399-Q7 Devkit

1 Introduction

The HDMI to CSI adapter is an add-On for the RK3399-Q7 Devkit. It can be plugged into the "Haikou" Development Board, which is the main component of the Devkit. It enables you to capture HDMI video by converting an incoming HDMI 1.4b stream to a MIPI CSI-2 stream as input for the RK3399-Q7.

For the conversion of HDMI into CSI the adapter uses the Toshiba TC358749XBG HDMI bridge.




HDMI to CSI adapter ("Peafowl")

The package contains the HDMI to CSI adapter (see picture above).


1.2 Mounting Instructions
